Haiti

In Haiti our partners have worked to build a rural local health clinic and cholera center which serves tens of thousands of children and families. Every day infants and children are brought to the clinic where the volunteers and nurses treat them for severe malnutrition or cholera. is not a rare occurrence to find a baby left at the front gate in the morning where a mother, having traveled many miles, abandons her dying child as her last resort.

Zambia

Our work in Zambia provides support to a clinic that specializes in caring for abandoned babies. Many times the babies are near death when they reach our partner's door. Fortunately, these babies are now getting the treatment they need to survive.
