### Haiti

In June of 2015, we partnered with a caring group of missionaries and volunteers to ship and provide over 270,000 meals for abandoned children in Haiti! Many of the children that we support live in rural mountain villages that are completely cut off from the outside world and have no idea when or where their next meal will come from. Our team prides itself on seeking out those children who often have no other source of hope for life-saving relief goods such as medicine and food.

## Zambia

In Zambia we help provide support for a lifesaving clinic which specializes in caring for abandoned babies. Many times the babies are near death when they reach our partner's door. Fortunately, these babies are now getting the specialized treatments they need to survive.

## Kenya

Our project partners in Kenya operate an orphanage that was first opened in 2001 to care for AIDS orphans. At that time there was only one small classroom with 13 children. Today the center has grown to an orphanage that provides care for more than 75 abanreceive the loving warmth of a household complete with food, education and most importantly tender loving care.
